



DAILY OPERATIONAL INFORMATION UPDATE

MANNVILLE PRODUCED WATER PIPELINE BREAK

August 14, 2018

This operational update will be provided daily until this incident is concluded.

Work accomplished in the past 24 hours

- Rain on Sunday August 12 made the area inaccessible for heavy equipment, therefore no additional soils were moved;
- Monitoring water collecting in bell holes, recovered 6m³, which was sent for safe disposal; and
- Observations of no apparent impact to wildlife, with perimeter fencing remaining in place.

Work forecast for next 24 hours

- Hydrovacating and digging to uncover pipeline to locate source of leak and begin failure analysis;
- Resume hauling of contaminated soil from containment areas to landfill; and
- Continue to monitor water collecting in bell holes and sending for disposal as appropriate.
